





**Where is it?** At 3-4 Warwick Street, off Regent Street in Soho.

**What is it?** A Japanese restaurant and sushi bar. The restaurant has recently been redesigned by Russell Sage and the new sushi bar opens this month.

**What's it got?** Situated on the lower ground floor and featuring a unique open grill that uses volcanic rocks sourced from Mount Fuji, the restaurant can seat up to 45 guests or hold receptions for up to 80. The sushi bar on the ground floor can accommodate up to 35 seated or 70 standing guests, while the entire venue can be hired out for up to 150 people. The décor is clean and contemporary and incorporates overlapping mirrors, intimate lighting and minimalist, wooden furniture.
